**Overview of NOI Fellowship experience:**

During the period from 23.10.2023 to 01.12.2023, I completed a study stay at the Institute Gustave Roussy in Paris.

During my stay, I had the opportunity to participate in large department visits led by the "chef de la clinique" and "senior" doctors. These meetings included detailed discussions of the patient's course of illness, evaluation of laboratory and imaging results, and subsequent planning of the next course of treatment.

I also participated in multidisciplinary meetings ("réunions de concertation pluridisciplinaire" - RCP), where the inclusion of patients in clinical trials was discussed and newly diagnosed patients were presented. Decisions were made on diagnostic and therapeutic procedures after a radiologist's interpretation of image documentation. There was also a discussion about patients who were already undergoing treatment and whether changes in the treatment strategy or a solution to complicated cases were required.

Apart from these meetings, I regularly attended outpatient consultations with leading doctors dealing with urogenital malignancies (Prof. K. Fizazi, Prof. L. Albiges, MD Y. Lorient, MD A. Bernard-Tessier, MD A. Patrikidou and MD N. Naoun. These consultations gave me familiarity with the management of patients in the outpatient clinic and with ongoing clinical trials at IGR. The doctors were always eager to answer my questions, and share comprehensive patient information, image documentation, and treatment procedures backed by clinical studies.
