### Overviewof NOI Fellowship experience:

- During my stay, I participated in surgical procedures under the guidance of Professor Singer and his
  colleagues from the Gastric and mixed Tumor (GMT) Service team. Surgical procedures were aimed
  at radical extirpation of tumors of mesenchymal origin in the limbs or retroperitoneum, GISTs, as well
  as malignant melanomas and Merkel cell carcinoma.
- I had the oportunity to attend outpatient clinic and consultations with Professor Singer and his colleagues from GMT (Dr. Aimee Craigo and Dr. Ned Bartlett), and also I could participate in outpatient clinical practice with clinical oncologists specializing in the treatment of soft tissue sarcomas Dr. Sandra D'Angelo one of the world experts for sarcomas treatment and main investigator of many sarcoma clinical trials and with her younger colleage Dr. Lauren Banks, with whom I participated in the diagnostic-therapeutic process.
- Regularly once a week, I took part in multidisciplinary meetings via zoom where the histopathologic findings were discussed and the decisions were made regarding the inclusion of patients in clinical trials as well as diagnostic and therapeutic procedures. Also I participated in radiological-surgical pre-operative evaluation of patients which included discussions about the patients' disease eventually its progression and further planning of the treatment strategies.

### Possible Knowledge Transfer for the Improvements in Oncology in Slovakia:

- Participation in the specialized fellowship in *Gastric and mixed Tumor Service* in MSKCC in New York City focused on the treatment of soft tissue sarcomas and GISTs has provided me with unique medical experiences that I have tried to implement in my everyday clinical practice.
- The knowledge, new treatment strategies as well as the perfect multidisciplinary cooperation I have observed during my fellowship give me the enthusiasm and chance to improve the patient's care in our institution



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- We continue in the effort of multidisciplinary cooperation with our colleages from pathology, surgery, radiotherapy and radiology as well, as this I consider to be one of the most important aspect of the treatment of these rare malignancies.
- Mutual sharing of the knowledge and clinical experiences contributes to the development of the
  professional team and inspire other colleages to participate in the international fellowships, what is
  inevitable for further improvement of our medical practice.
- Thanks to the intership I have a connection and contacts with international experts, which give me the possibility to consult rare clinical cases and eventually participate in the international clinical trials.
- I have presented the experiences and inspirations from my fellowship in a lecture at the 2024 Young Oncologists' Days.
